5. CITIZENS FROM THE FLOOR

Tim Wagner – Plant Manager for Vlasic – Announced that they were now officially part of Conagra. He stated that Vlasic was not denying the excessive use of water, but they wanted to get a good understanding of the numbers being presented. He stated that Vlasic has been very successfully working with The City Manager Tom Youatt and the DPW Superintendent Ed Priehs in review of the data presented by Stantec. Special meetings were arranged with Vlasic and GLWA. Tim stated that the relationship between the City and Conagra- "we will always do what is right". **City Manager Tom Youatt** stated that Vlasic and the City will continue working together to reduce peak water usage.

6. NEW BUSINESS

A. Water and Sewer Rate Increases for Vlasic

City Manager Tom Youatt presented the proposal for the rate increases for Vlasic as follows: Water Rates to increase by 20% and Sewer Rates to increase by 9% for the period of one year retroactive to October 1, 2018.

Youatt stated that the City and Vlasic will be working together, to put together a capital improvement plan to show GLWA that the peak hour water usage can be reduced.

Motion by Tanis, seconded by Ramirez to increase the Water Rate to Vlasic by 20% and increase the Sewer Rate by 9% for the period of one year, retroactive from October 1, 2018 as presented. Please see attached Water/Sewer Rate Increases.
