**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-20
RESOLUTION TO AMEND SECTION 3.5 OF CHARTER**

At a meeting of the City Commission of the City of Imlay City held on the 5th day of November 2020, this Resolution was offered by Davis and supported by Rowden:

WHEREAS, the Imlay City Commission has determined that the portion of Section 3.5 of its City Charter referring to the commencement of office does not comply with current Michigan election law;

WHEREAS, MCL 117.3b provides that a City may provide by resolution any election provision that is consistent with Michigan election law; and

WHEREAS, the Imlay City Commission desires to amend Section 3.5 of its City Charter, as described above, to conform with Michigan election law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the provisions of existing section 3.5 of the Charter of the City of Imlay City to amended to read as follows:

Section 3.5 Elective Officers and Terms of Office:

The elective officers of the City shall be a City Commission of 7 members, one of whom shall in turn be elected by the commission as City Mayor. At each regular city election, four commissioners shall be elected on a single ballot. Each elector shall be entitled to vote for not more than four candidates. The three candidates receiving the highest number of votes shall be elected for a term of four years and the candidate receiving the fourth highest number of votes shall be elected for a term of two years, all such terms shall commence at the first regular or special meeting following the certification of the election results.
