**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-21
RESOLUTION TO AMEND SECTION 3.6 OF CHARTER**

At a meeting of the City Commission of the City of Imlay City held on the 5th day of November 2020, this Resolution was offered by Davis and supported by Sadler:

WHEREAS, the Imlay City Commission has determined that the portion of Section 3.6 of its City Charter referring to the nominating petition filing deadline does not conform to Michigan election law;

WHEREAS, MCL 117.3b provides that a City may provide by resolution any election provision that is consistent with Michigan election law; and

WHEREAS, the Imlay City Commission desires to amend Section 3.6 of its City Charter, as described above, to conform with Michigan election law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the provisions of existing section 3.6 of the Charter of the City of Imlay City to amended to read as follows:

Section 3.6 Nominations:

The method of nomination of the elective officers shall be by petition signed by not less than twenty-five nor more than fifty qualified electors of the city. No person shall sign his or her name to a greater number of petitions for office than there will be persons elected to said office at said election. Where the signature of any individual appears on more petitions than he or she is so permitted to sign, such signatures shall be counted only to the extent he or she is so permitted to sign in the order of the respective dates of filing the petitions containing such signatures.

Nominating petitions shall be filed with the City Clerk by 4:00 p.m. on the fifteenth Tuesday preceding the election. The Clerk shall publish notice of the last day so permitted for filing petitions at least one week before, and not more than three weeks before, such last day.


