The purpose of the hearing us to consider a variance application from Lapeer County Agricultural Society (Mr. Ian Kempf) on behalf of Mr. and Mrs. Dennis Hall who are in the process of purchasing Parcel I19-87-700-000-00 on Third St. The Halls wish to place a new single-family home on the non-conforming lot (5175 square feet) of record but cannot meet the current front or rear yard setbacks. The Halls are requesting a variance from the Schedule of Regulations in a Residential (R-1) District to reduce the required front yard from 30' to 25' and a second variance to reduce the required rear yard from 35' to 25'.
